Den and Bobbie wrote all 10 faith-based songs here, and they deliver them with Bobbie's usual clear-as-a-bell vocals and Den's usual instrumental magic. Bobbie is one of a small number of top Gospel performers who was actually born in Nashville. Both of her parents played Christian music, and she began touring with a Gospel trio at age 17. Den began playing in church at 12 and was on the road by 15. He is remarkably proficient on countless stringed instruments, from mandolin to pedal steel. One of the strongest tunes here is *Is Anything Too Hard For God*, while *Lord, I'll Be There Soon* and the title song are also powerful. The Scripture reference "look for the old road" is from Jeremiah 6:16, which in the NIV is translated; "This is what the Lord says: 'Stand at the crossroads and look; ask for the ancient paths, ask where the good way is, and walk in it...'
